This is an explanatory statement given to all Shareholders relating to the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the AGM authorising the Repurchase Mandate.

This explanatory statement contains all the information required pursuant to Rule 10.06(1)(b) of the Listing Rules which is set out as follows:

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued and fully paid up share capital of the Company comprised 1,258,296,800 Shares and outstanding Options which are exercisable into 134,000,000 Shares. The exercise price for 84,800,000 Options, 44,200,000 Options and 5,000,000 Options are HK\$0.46 per share, HK\$0.86 per share and HK\$2.95 per share respectively.

Exercised in full of the Repurchase Mandate, if so approved, on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the approval of the Repurchase Mandate generally (not taking into account of exercising the subscription rights attaching to the outstanding Options as at the Latest Practicable Date), the Company would be allowed under the repurchase resolution to repurchase a maximum of 125,829,680 Shares during the period from the date on which such resolution is passed until the date of (i) conclusion of the next AGM of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next AGM of the Company is required by the Bye-laws or any applicable laws of Bermuda to be held; or (iii) the revocation, variation or removal of the Repurchase Mandate by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first, representing not more than 10% of the issued share capital of the Company as at the Latest Practicable Date.

2. REASONS FOR THE REPURCHASE

- (i) Any Shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the meeting convened by the above notice is entitled to appoint a proxy in respect of the whole or any part of his holding of shares to attend and vote in his stead. A proxy need not be a Shareholder of the Company.
- (ii) In order to be valid, the form of proxy, together with any power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or other authority, must be deposited at the principal place of business of the Company located at 37th Floor, China Online Centre, 333 Lockhart Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong, not less than 48 hours prior to the meeting.
